Context

Making for Climate Change aims to enable LGBTQ+ young people and d/Deaf young people to take creative action to address the Climate Emergency.

It is part of our long-term project Making for Change which has engaged young people in thinking about craftivism (craft and activism) over a 10-year period.

Last year we did some research with young people and they told us that climate change was a really important issue for them. They also told us some young people can face barriers to getting involved in social action for the environment.

Through this project we are interested in supporting youth voice, enabling exploration of the climate emergency and potential solutions through creative activity and providing development opportunities for young people.

Your Role

Help us to capture stories of impact (5 minimum) from young people connected to the programme either as participants or in creative roles.

We want to further understand the role and impact that making can have in helping young people to explore the climate emergency, have their voice heard and make a change in themselves and their community.

oldfirestation.org.uk but are open to any approach which focuses on stories as a tool for measuring impact.

£1800 based on 5 days' work at £360 day to be covered flexibly according to the project's needs Mid-March to Mid-August 2024.

Payment

You will be paid in stages with the first payment on receipt of a signed contract.
